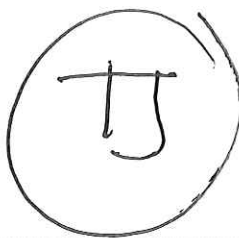

America's Top Illusionist Rob Lake Returns Home For Animal Rescue Benefit Show at Norman's Nancy O'Brian Center for the Performing Arts, Jan. 25

(OKLAHOMA CITY) – DEC. 29, 2016 – One of the world's most celebrated illusionists and native Oklahoman Rob Lake will return home to the Oklahoma City area for a special one-night-only benefit show at Norman's Nancy O'Brian Center for the Performing Arts on Wednesday, Jan. 25.

Dazzling and entertaining millions over the last decade with his awe-inspiring original illusions, the youngest recipient ever of the coveted Merlin Award will whisk away his fellow Oklahomans on a mind-bending magical adventure when he brings his show, "The Magic of Rob Lake," to the Center next month.

Proceeds from the show will be granted to a cause Lake holds near and dear to his heart -- Animal Rescue -- and one in which he champions daily. In fact, Lake's own furry companion Roger, a Yorkie mutt, was once a rescue dog, and is now a popular part of his show as well.

The two beneficiaries of the one-night event will be the Norman Animal Shelter and Friends for Folks (friendsforfolks.org). Proceeds from the evening will aid in both organizations' dedication to animal rescue efforts, including Friends for Folks' mission to pair unadoptable dogs with Oklahoma state correctional inmates for a training program to become service dogs and to make dogs adoptable.

In Early January, Lake will wrap up a two-week residency of his mesmerizing show at Harrah's Lake Tahoe Hotel and Casino, presented by Epic Creative Productions. Over the last few years, Lake has traveled around the world bringing his physics- and sometimes even death-defying illusions to audiences at the sun-soaked Atlantis Paradise Island Resort in Nassau, Bahamas; Atlantic City's Taj Mahal; New York's Times Square, on the Las Vegas Strip, and even at the White House. He's even performed his epic illusions on national network television.

Lake also recently returned from his 10th annual world tour bringing his show to U.S. military personnel and their families stationed overseas throughout Europe. Over the last decade, he's entertained American troops throughout Asia, Oceania, and other remote areas of the globe.
