# APRIL 4, 2015

NOWC1421 - WORLD RELIEF CHICAGO (ORIG AIR 9/13/15)

They talk about the mission of World Relief, how its programs are designed to help people, and about immigration law reform. He explains his story and why he believes World Relief is a valuable organization in Chicago.
