2. Prepare an inventory of the assets of the Estate within three months after your appointment and furnish it to any interested persons who request it. See 18-C M.R.S. §3-706 and Maine Probate Form DE-405.

Your letter of acceptance of this position and trust was received on JUNE 28, 2023, and is conclusive evidence of your acceptance of your fiduciary obligations. You may be held personally liable for any violation of your duties under law with respect to the position you have accepted.
