We have completed our review of the response of Capstar TX LLC, debtor in possession, licensee of the above-noted stations, to the June 19, 2018, random audit letter sent to it in accordance with the provisions of 47 C.F.R. § 73.2080(f)(4) of the Commission's Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) rules.
