A beekeeper (or apiarist) keeps bees in order to collect their honey and other products that the hive produces (including beeswax, pollen, and royal jelly), to pollinate crops, or to produce bees for sale to other beekeepers. They talk about the Bee Festival, the importance of bees in agriculture, and how to handle the Africanized Honey Bee (AHB), Africanized refers to the hybrid that results from African and European bees mating.

Abigail talks about this chronic condition, symptoms (i.e. excessive bleeding, painful periods), causes, and provides statistics that 1 of every 10 women suffer from endometriosis.
