"B" varieties open as female on the afternoon of the first day, close in late afternoon and re-open in the male phase the following morning. Eric also talks about avocado production, pollination and varieties like Butler, Hass, Bacon, Fuerte and Pinkerton.

These may include changes in sleep, appetite, energy level, concentration, daily behavior, or self-esteem. Depression can also be associated with thoughts of suicide.

Chronic stress puts pressure on the body for an extended period. This can cause a range of symptoms and increase the risk of developing certain illnesses.
