Injuries

WPOZ/WDOZ/WHYZ/WMYZ/WCYZ aired (1) 3-minute interview segment during Z88.3 Mornings with Ellis and Tyler on 10.04.22 between 8:15-8:20 a.m. Dr. Timothy Hendrix, Medical Director of AdventHealth Centra Care, was their guest. With many central Floridians dealing with the aftermath of Hurricane Ian, Dr. Hendrix talked about an increase in injuries, including cuts, scrapes, and burns. He discussed being safe when clearing debris and what kinds of injuries may require a visit to a doctor for a tetanus shot.

Disaster Recovery [Seminole County]

Acid Reflux

Dr. Hendrix explained that it is common to see an increase in cases of acid reflux after the holidays as many people consume more caffeine, eat larger meals, and have a change of diet this time of year. To avoid it, he suggested some over-the-counter medications that may help as well as avoiding various triggers. He also explained that a doctor can prescribe stronger medication if the over-the-counter options do not help.

Pet Health
