Re: KRTK-TV Election of Retransmission Consent

Dear Ms. Acebo:

Pursuant to the Cable Television Consumer Protection and Competition Act of 1992 and Section 76.64 of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission, Station KTRK-TV, Houston, TX, located in the Houston, TX designated market area (the "Station"), hereby elects retransmission consent with respect to carriage of the digital signal of the Station on all systems, headends, and franchises owned by, controlled by, or affiliated with the above-referenced entity, in all communities and franchise areas served by such systems, headends, and franchises, for the three-year period commencing January 1, 2012 and ending December 31, 2014 during which you are operating and are licensed as a qualifying cable system or multichannel video programming distributor (MVPD) under the Act. This election covers all of your systems, headends, and franchise areas.

Our grant of retransmission consent does not, of course, include the underlying copyrights, which you must clear under the terms of the compulsory license in Section 111 of the United States Copyright Act of 1976, as amended (17 U.S.C. § 111) or otherwise. In no event shall any systems, headends or franchises owned by, controlled by or affiliated with the above-referenced entities have "must-carry" rights with respect to the Station and its signals.
