The show is also rebroadcast early the following morning during the "KCSU Podcast Corner" program on Wednesdays and Fridays, between 6:00 am and 7:00 am.

The show covers campus, local, and national events, music, entertainment, and environmental news through a local lens. The show also includes interviews and feature pieces created by hosts Lee Zimpel and Tyler Weatherwax, highlighting local community members, businesses, and events.

# October 17, 2023: "CSU research improvements, new community center, Elijah McClain case momentum"

**Description:** Tyler Weatherwax reports campus news with information on research at Colorado State University improving in a handful of ways through several upgrades to some on-campus buildings. Lee Zimpel covers local news on the new community center coming soon to southeast Fort Collins, which will feature a new outdoor pool and library. Weatherwax highlights some upcoming opportunities to enjoy some local live music in events news. Then, Lee Zimpel goes over national news on the recent trials of the three Aurora police officers and two paramedics involved in the death of 23-year-old Elijah McClain, who was killed after the police encounter in 2019. KCSU's Austin Martin delivers all things sports in the CSU sports recap for last week. This episode wraps with Zimpel's report on the week's weather forecast.

# November 2, 2023: "Clark professor petition, domestic violence legal service ending, Toyota mass recall"

**Description:** Tyler Weatherwax reports campus news on professors working in the Clark building starting a petition against Colorado State University to speed up the building's renovation following recent flooding. Lee Zimpel covers local news on a free legal service for domestic violence survivors in northern Colorado coming to an end due to funding issues. Weatherwax outlines events news with a variety of weekend events, from live music to the Old Town lighting ceremony. Then, Lee Zimpel goes over national news with information on Toyota recalling 1.9 million RAV4 models to fix a problem where turning sharply could cause the car to catch fire. Tyler Weatherwax delivers the latest updates in CSU sports. This episode wraps with Zimpel's report on the weekend weather forecast.

November 16, 2023: "Discuss Better recap, Fort Collins arsons under investigation, setter Emery Herman"

**Description:** Tyler Weatherwax reports campus news with a recap of CSU's Discuss Better, an event where Democratic Gov. Jared Polis came together with Republican Gov. Spencer Cox of Utah to demonstrate "healthy, well-mannered political talk." Lee Zimpel covers local news on police investigating a series of arson and graffiti cases in a northeastern Fort Collins neighborhood. Weatherwax goes through events news on upcoming live music and theater performances. Then, Lee Zimpel goes over national news on the Colorado lawsuit aiming to bar Donald Trump from the state's presidential ballot coming to a close as final arguments are heard. Austin Martin and Kaleb Allen sit down with CSU volleyball setter Emery Herman for an after-practice interview. The episode wraps with the weekend weather forecast.

## December 5, 2023 September 14, 2023: "LSC winter closure, CHSAA partnership, Gaza airstrikes resume"

**Description:** Tyler Weatherwax covers campus news with information on the Lory Student Center closing without power through most of winter break. Lee Zimpel reports local news on the fresh partnership between CSU and the Colorado High School Activities Association, and what that means for Fort Collins moving forward. Weatherwax lays out some of the week's upcoming local events. Then, Lee Zimpel goes through national news on the major development in the Israel-Hamas war that saw airstrikes resuming in Gaza over the weekend. Kaleb Allen delivers the latest in CSU sports. The episode wraps with Zimpel sharing the week's weather forecast.
