The actual date for the formal opening/dedication of the new building has not been set at this time. Mr. Danner expressed his satisfaction with the way the project has moved along. Mr. Danner has kept citizens updated throughout the construction process by way of his frequent appearances as a guest on our "FOCUS" public affairs program.
