Newly-elected Monterey Mayor J.J. Reels was on WLIV FM to outline his vision for the weeks ahead as he begins his term as the town's new top official.

Mayor Reels was interviewed by our Roger Ealey.

During the interview, Mayor Reels told our listeners one of the topics he heard mentioned the most in his recently-completed successful campaign for Mayor of Monterey was concerns expressed by citizens that the town needs more retail stores and additional sit-down restaurants. The Mayor says he plans to work diligently on both starting immediately.

The new sewer system which will be completed in about 24 months will double the current systems capacity – the new Mayor says – and that will allow for the growth he envisions in the retail and dining segments.

Continued improvement of the city's sidewalks is also a top priority of the new Mayor. He says "sidewalks equal safety" and he wants to see sidewalk improvement a high priority in the Town of Monterey.
