The Livingston Board of Aldermen voted (in their September 9th meeting) to sell 10.3 acres of land in the city industrial park to an unmaed manufacturer of automotive parts.

The proposed new manufacturing facility will create approximately 100 new jobs in the Livingston labor market.

The new facotory will be located off Tennessee Drive and the facility will occupy a new – yet to be built – 100,000 square foot building.

The Mayor, appearing on our “FOCUS ON COMMUNITY” feature (heard on WLIV AM and WLIV FM) told our audience the manufacturer will be making a formal announcement in the near future
