The use of cellular phones by motorists has long been the topic of concern for many. Cell phone use distractions while driving have proven tragic on a number of occasions.

Beginning January 1, 2018, it became a Class C misdemeanor to knowingly talk on a cell phone while operating a motor vehicle within a marked school zone area.

Some variations of the penalty are allowed depending on the age of the driver and whether using a hand-held or a hands-free phone.

Both stations – WLIV AM and WLIV FM – aired news coverage of the new law and further worked to make the public aware of this new law about to take effect by including additional coverage through live reads and recorded public service information.
