The Town of Monterey will observe its 40th annual celebration of Standing Stone Day on Saturday, October 12 with a full day of events (parade, ceremony at the stone,, etc.) planned for residents and town visitors alike.

Standing Stone Day recognizes the standing stone monument and the town's connection to native Americans. Mr. Welch was our guest on "Focus On Community" and outlined the schedule for the entire day's celebration.

While on our "Focus" programming, Mr. Welch also talked about an upcoming November 2nd community play which will tell the story of when – for almost three decades – local Doctors Collins and Craine operated Monterey's own local hospital. The facility was open from October, 1945 through July, 1975.
