Livingston and Overton County look forward to community activities in the new Central Park, located on South Spring Street. However, this summer has seen only limited park offerings due to health concerns.

WLIV's guest on FOCUS ON COMMUNITY was Shannon Cantrell - who not only serves as marketing and tourism director for our local chamber of commerce but also oversees activities and scheduling at Central Park.

Shannon explained to our listeners that the community has been kept from having the events it otherwise would have had – in the absence of health concerns caused by Covid 19.

One of the biggest events of the year is Falloween which has been held for several Octobers and ties in with the observance of Halloween. Shannon says Falloween organizers and promoters still hope to have the 2020 event but it's too soon to make definite declarations as to what will be held.

Shannon told our audience safety of everyone is the primary consideration going forward as officials focus on what events will and will not be held in Livingston's Central Park.
