Sunday, April 3

The decision not to charge two Minneapolis police officers in the shooting death of Jamar Clark is being met with a wide range of reactions - from anger and disappointment to relief and vindication. In light of the community reaction to Hennepin County Attorney Mike Freeman's decision, Governor Dayton is urging lawmakers to pass his series of proposals aimed at eliminating racial economic disparities in Minnesota. Congressman Tom Emmer joins us in studio, discussing his recent trip to Cuba and who he plans to support in the presidential race.

Sunday, April 10

Improving the state's mental health facilities is one of Governor Dayton's biggest focuses in this legislative session. We break down proposals to fund improvements to the Minnesota Security Hospital in St. Peter and the Anoka Metro Regional Treatment Center. The parents of a young man found dead near the Stone Arch Bridge in Minneapolis are pushing for a bill to pass that would give family members access to a person's "digital data" after they die. We examine what will happen to Minnesota's delegates who voted for Marco Rubio during the Super Tuesday caucuses.

Sunday, April 17

We now have a better idea of how the various political parties want to spend the state's \$900 million surplus. Senate DFL leaders unveiled their proposal this week. MnDOT unveiled its list of road projects for the 2016 construction season and warned lawmakers of the need to pass long-term, comprehensive transportation funding. Dozens of people packed a House committee hearing this week to testify for and against a bill that would protect business owners who require people to use the bathroom based on their gender at birth.

Sunday, April 24

This week, we are looking back at the life and legacy of Prince. The iconic musician and Minnesota native was found dead at his Paisley Park studios in Chanhassen. We're also looking at the "wealth migration" issue and discuss whether higher taxes are driving wealthy Minnesotans to other states.

Sunday, May 1

State lawmakers are nearing a critical point as they work out how to handle a \$900 million budget surplus. With less than a month left in the legislative session, this could set the stage for some bumpy negotiations. Governor Dayton announced the creation of two task forces this week - one to address mental health, the second to look at fixing racial economic disparities.

Former Minneapolis mayor R.T. Rybak joins us in studio to talk about his new book "Pothole Confidential".

Sunday, May 8

Republicans in Minnesota's Second Congressional District endorsed Jason Lewis to run in November. He will likely still face a primary challenge in August. Senate Democrats have made the first major move towards a compromise on transportation funding, but Republicans have made it clear they remain strongly opposed to raising the gas tax.

Sunday, May 15

The battle lines over transportation funding will be drawn on Monday. Governor Dayton and legislative leaders still need to work out compromises on transportation, taxes and a package of building projects. We talk to Senate leaders Jeff Hayden (DFL-Minneapolis) and David Hann (R-Eden Prairie) about what's left to do with one week left in the session. A new attempt to lift the ban on Sunday liquor sales in Minnesota failed again at the Capitol this past week. However, there's evidence it's slowly gaining support among Minnesota lawmakers.

Sunday, May 22

The countdown is on to the final hours of the 2016 Legislative session at the State Capitol. Several key items remain in limbo, including a transportation funding package, a bonding bill and a tax bill. Governor Dayton has insisted he will not call a special session in the event lawmakers do not pass these bills by the midnight deadline. Minnesota Republicans spent the weekend in the Duluth for the State GOP Convention.

Sunday, June 5

The debate over special session negotiations is turning into a scene from the movie "Groundhog Day." Governor Dayton and GOP lawmakers blame each other for a messy end to the 2016 legislative session and an inability to come to an agreement on terms for a special session. U.S. Senator Ron Johnson of Wisconsin joins Tom Hauser in studio.

Sunday, June 12

Talks are set to resume later this week between Governor Dayton and lawmakers on Wednesday to determine if a special session will take place. Two state senators join Tom Hauser in studio to discuss where negotiations stand. FOX News contributor Pete Hegseth joins Tom in studio to discuss his new book, "In The Arena."

Sunday, June 19

Governor Dayton and lawmakers met again this week without reaching an agreement on a special session. The sticking point appears to be state funding for the Southwest Light Rail line

from Minneapolis to Eden Prairie. The mass shooting at an Orlando nightclub has reignited the local and national debate over gun control laws. Author Shawn Otto joins Tom Hauser in studio to discuss his book *The War on Science*, and how science plays a role in politics and creating public policy.

Sunday, June 26

Gun control is taken up in the U.S. House and Senate this week. The House holds a 25-hour long sit-in, demanding a vote, and the Senate votes down several measures. All of this comes in the wake of the Orlando attack at the Pulse nightclub. Here in Minnesota new safety measures are discussed for the State Capitol. Governor Dayton meets with legislative leaders, once again, to discuss a Special Session, but they remain at a standstill. The U.S. Supreme Court makes three big rulings this week, including a deadlock on immigration, putting a stop to President Obama's plan to shield millions of undocumented people from deportation. Host Tom Hauser takes us all the way to the top of the State Capitol as the \$310 million dollar restoration project nears the homestretch. Our analysts also touch on the United Kingdom's decision to leave the European Union.
