Quarterly report of “Issues Covered” for the FCC and WHCM records.

From the period of July 1st to September 30th, WHCM 88.3 FM aired 10,800 total PSAs and promos in that time frame. These PSAs and promos covered an array of topics, among those were COVID-19, hunger, disaster preparedness, texting and driving, caregiving, Alzheimer awareness and local area PSA’s such as promotions for the IDEAshop, makerspace and Elk Grove Enclave. We also ran a variety of promotions for shows on the station in addition to the previously listed PSA’s. Hosts continued to broadcast shows remotely while the station was closed due to campus closure, however some returned to live production as campus gradually reopened.
