Section I. Issues

The station has identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community in this quarter.

- A. **Education.** Issues relating to public school education in our community
- B. **Unemployment-** Joblessness is high in our community.
- C. **Local Economy-** The local business climate is very important to our community.
- D. **Recreation-** “Things to do” are at a minimum in our community.
- E. **Cancer-** Many people in our community die from cancer.

Section II. Responsive Programs

The station has broadcast programming dealing with each of the above-referenced issues. Programming dealing with each issue is set out below.

- A. **Education:**
During various programs we help to support and promote all of the local schools. We announce their events and fundraisers and sporting events.
- B. **Unemployment:**
We broadcast “help wanted” advertisements for local businesses needing help. This allows those looking for jobs to find them.
- C. **Local Economy:**
By cooperating with the local Chambers of Commerce, we are able to help promote business in the local economy.
- D. **Recreation:**
“*Community Bulletin Board*”- Airs three times each day during the quarter with information about things to do, most of them free, in our community. The listings are free to any organization.
- E. **Cancer:**
“*Relay For Life*”- the station helps promote the annual American Cancer Society’s Relay for Life
