

<p>Prior to the filing of the station's license renewal application on December 1, 2014, the station must air announcements on October 1, October 16, November 1 and November 16, 2014 with the text provided below (for a total of four).</p> <p>At least two of the required announcements must air between 6:00 PM and 11:00 PM local time.</p> <p>These announcements should be communicated aurally and should also be accompanied by visuals with the studio address and the FCC's address on-screen when this information is being communicated aurally by the announcer.</p>	<p>After the filing of the station's license renewal application, the station must air announcements on December 1, December 16, 2014, and January 1, January 16, February 1 and February 16, 2015 with the text provided below (for a total of six).</p> <p>At least three of the required announcements must air between 6:00 PM and 11:00 PM local time.</p> <p>At least one announcement must air between 9:00 AM and 1:00 PM.</p> <p>At least one announcement must air between 1:00 PM and 5:00 PM.</p> <p>At least one announcement must air between 5:00 PM and 7:00 PM.</p> <p>These announcements should be communicated aurally and should also be accompanied by visuals with the studio address and the FCC's address on-screen when this information is being communicated aurally by the announcer.</p>
