1	Participate in Job Fair	On September 28, 2016, our SEU participated in and was a co-sponsor of The City of Massillon Job Fair, in conjunction with The City of Massillon, The Independent and Monster, Massillon West Stark Chamber of Commerce and Ohio Means Jobs-Stark County. Our General Sales Manager represented our SEU at this event, during which he spoke with attendees about career opportunities in radio broadcasting as well as job openings within our SEU. This event was promoted on all SEU stations.
2	Host event/program sponsored by or on behalf of an educational institution relating to careers in broadcasting	On May 10, 2017, our SEU hosted a student attending Bowling Green University to “job shadow” our Midday FM On-Air Personality to learn about what this job entails both on and off the air. The student also received a tour of the studios and meet and conversed with other staff members about operations and career opportunities.
