

Consistent with the Commission's Order on interim digital operations, Lincoln Financial Media Company of California hereby supplies the following information in support of this notification.

1. The Station commenced digital broadcast on February 2, 2009.
2. Lincoln Financial Media Company of California hereby certifies its facilities conform to the iBiquity Digital Corporation hybrid FM specifications.

4. Transmitter Power Output:  
10,500 watts analog and 105 watts digital utilizing low level combining at the exciter and a Nautel model NV20 transmitter.
5. Lincoln Financial Media Company of California certifies its analog effective radiated power will remain as authorized after commencement of digital operations.

6. Lincoln Financial Media Company of California hereby certifies that its interim digital operations will not cause human exposure to levels of radio frequency radiation in excess of Section 1.1310 of the Commission's rules and is therefore categorically excluded from the environmental processing pursuant to Section 1.1306(b).

Lincoln Financial Media Company of California hereby requests that this notification be accepted *nuct pro tunc* as of February 12, 2009. During a recent review of the Station's files the Licensee determined that the instant notification had not been timely filed by local engineering personnel. No interference has been reported and all other requirements with respect to the digital operation are in compliance with the Commission's Rules.
