Public Service Announcements/Programs and Issues Report for WDUZ-FM: April, May and June 2023

In our ongoing effort to serve the public interest WDUZ-FM Brillion/Green Bay broadcasts programming responsive to issues of concern to Brillion/Green Bay and the surrounding area. The following is a list of those issues:

Issue covered:

Make A Wish Wisconsin with Bergstrom Automotive

Program: The Fan promoted the Bergstrom Make A Wish Drive for Dreams that raises money for the foundation. Bill and Rookie also auctioned off a Jordan Love autographed framed jersey that sold for \$1,500 for Make A Wish. Bill and Rookie also promoted that listeners could get a \$30 discount on an oil change with a \$15 donation to Make A Wish. These were supported with 25 live promotional announcements from June 19th through the 23rd when the auction took place. We also did a live interview with a representative of Make a Wish Wisconsin the morning of June 23rd. We also placed a link to the information and to donate on our website.

Issue Covered: Kiwanis Memorial Day Parade and acknowledge of D-Day

Length: 10 :30 live promotional mentions promoting the annual parade that takes place on Memorial Day in DePere. WDUZ also spent 15 minutes on June 3rd to address D-Day. In that segment Bill Rabeor gave a description of the day in history and how it happened and its meaning all these years later.

Issue Covered: The Bellin Run
