Since 1971, KNOM continues to produce and air local & regional issue-oriented news and local feature programming. This quarter, newscasts ranged from approx. 6 to 12-minutes at :02 five times a day Monday-Friday: 7AM, 8AM, 9AM, Noon, & 5PM.

The station routinely covers local city and tribal meetings and issues, such as the Nome Common Council, the Nome School Board and Norton Sound Regional Hospital (NSHC). Other issues this quarter included COVID-19 updates, search and rescue efforts, traditional Native Diet and Activities, Covid-19 testing sites and opportunities, Alaska State Fisheries special announcements, police and tribal concerns, weather and climate differences, health mandates, resource challenges in villages, and seasonal hunting/fishing regulations.
