On **September 25th, 2012** (date of the last renewal grant), **WRDL** (station's call letters) was granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until **October 1st, 2020** (license expiration date). Our license will expire on **October 1st, 2020** (date). We filed an application for license renewal with the FCC. A copy of this application is available for inspection at www.fcc.gov. It contains information concerning the station's performance over the last **8 years** (period of time covered by the application, e.g. 8 years).

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal application, and to whether this station has operated in the public interest, should file comments and petitions with the FCC by **September 1st, 2020** (date, first day of the full calendar month prior to the month of license expiration).
