Vaccination clinics are being planned throughout Arkansas on Saturday for kids now eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine. On Tuesday, federal regulators approved the Pfizer vaccine for children ages 5 through 11. After some problems Wednesday with not all health units having the vaccine, the Department of Health says all units have now received shipments. Richard Taffner, an epidemiologist with the department, says there likely will be plenty of vaccines available for those who turn out Saturday.
