

A jury trial for former Craighead County Clerk Kade Holliday is expected to begin today (Monday) after allegedly stealing millions of dollars while in office. His attorney's earlier this month filed a request to move the trial's venue, as KASU's Brandon Tabor reports.

The Jonesboro Sun reported that attorneys for Holliday requested that his trial in circuit court be moved out of Craighead arguing that he deserves a fair trial since every juror - quote - "will be a victim of the offenses outlined."

Holliday back in September 2020 agreed to repay public funds he allegedly stole from the county which is more than \$1-point-4-million-dollars.

He was arrested back in June 2020 and is facing 13 counts of felony theft of property and one count of abuse of office.

Holliday has plead not guilty to the charges.

Meanwhile, Holliday has also been indicted by a federal grand jury, in which - if convicted - could face 20 years in prison and a fine of up to \$250,000.
