A Bowie County Sheriff's Office inmate is at large after running away during a transfer early Wednesday, according to a press release.

Kylon Chevon Clark, 20, of Hooks, took off running as BCSO staff was transferring inmates from the Bi-State Justice Building Jail to the annex jail about 3 a.m. Wednesday in downtown Texarkana.

"While loading inmates in a van in the basement of the Bi-State Building, Inmate Clark was able to make it out of the basement. Sergeant Zacherias Price chased Inmate Clark, but eventually lost sight of him around Fourth and Main streets," the press release states.

Clark was being held on a charge of indecency with a child.

He is a black male described as 5 feet 8 inches tall and weighing 150 pounds. He was last seen wearing blue jail clothing and handcuffs.

The Texarkana Texas Police Department, the Texarkana Arkansas Police Department and BCSO have searched the area where he was last seen without success, the release states.

Investigators with the Bowie County Sheriff's Office were called in to start following up on additional leads.
