The annual Hot Springs Documentary Film Festival begins Friday. This year, organizers are celebrating its 30th anniversary and will be hosting in-person events. Most documentaries will have at least one screening, either at the Malco Theater or the Arlington Hotel, and be available virtually. Festival Executive Director Jennifer Gerber says returning to in-person screenings was important.
