TEXRKANA, Texas -- Two brothers have been arrested on murder charges in Monday's shooting death of a 17-year-old Texas High School student at Moores Lane and Sidney Drive.

Kamorion Meachem, 18, and Kieran Meachem, 19, have been booked into the Bi-State jail, according to Texarkana Texas police. Bond has been set at \$1 million for each brother.

The victim has been identified as 17- year-old Ulises Martinez.

Detectives have been able to determine that there was an altercation between Kamorion and Ulises at Texas High School earlier in the day. After they were both suspended, they continued to communicate with each other and eventually met on Sidney Drive to fight a little before 2 p.m. Monday. At some point during that street fight, which also involved several other teenagers, Martinez was shot once in the chest and died at the scene.

Several people, including Kamorian and Kieran Meachem, were transported from the scene and interviewed by detectives at the police department. The two brothers were later arrested.

TTPD spokesman Shawn Vaughn said that the investigation is in the early stages and that no motive has yet been determined
