DE QUEEN, Ark. — A suspect who allegedly assaulted a Sevier County Sheriff's investigator Wednesday morning and was the focus of a manhunt was captured without incident.

Law enforcement from multiple agencies searched near Dierks Lake for the suspect, identified as Justin Thomas Keaster, 39. Keaster was taken into custody Wednesday afternoon, according to a news release from the Sevier County Sheriff's Office.

Keaster was allegedly involved in a high-speed pursuit with the Arkansas State Police early Tuesday after he fled in a stolen truck. He later allegedly ambushed a Sevier County investigator, stole his gun and patrol vehicle, and then fled. The patrol vehicle was later found near Dierks Lake.

The investigator is being treated at medical center for treatment of an injury sustained during the altercation.

Keaster was considered armed and extremely dangerous. The public was urged not to approach him and contact authorities immediately.
