

TEXARKANA, Texas — Police have a capital murder warrant for a 16-year-old suspect in the Dec.13 shooting at the Oaks at Rosehill Apartments.

Two men were killed and one injured after the 5 p.m. shooting at the Texarkana public housing complex.

Police obtained the warrant Monday and were actively searching for the teenage suspect, said Texarkana Texas Police Spokesman Shawn Vaughn.

The call came in to police on Dec.13 as an “unknown problem,” Vaughn said. When police arrived, they found one man outside the apartment and two inside. One man was dead at the scene and two others were taken to local hospitals in critical condition, Vaughn said. One of the men taken to the hospital died shortly after arrival.

The other victim remains in serious condition at a Little Rock hospital.
