"The rink, provided by Artificial Ice and Events of Perfect Party Entertainment, will be set up next to the Perot on Main Street," said Rashinda Hampton, director of marketing and communications for the Perot Theater.

The exhibitor will provide the skates.

The rink, measuring 40 ft by 50 ft, will accommodate skaters from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. Skaters will get to skate for 30 minutes per session. The last group will be welcomed onto the rink at 9 pm and their session will be complete at 9:30 pm. The show will be over at that point.
