TEXARKANA, Ark. -- Southeastern Oklahoma State University is back in the Farmers Bank and Trust Live United Bowl, and the Savage Storm is just the third team to make a repeat appearance in the annual NCAA, Division II bowl game.

The Savage Storm (8-3) will face the Emporia State University Hornets (6-5) at noon on Saturday, Dec. 4 at Razorback Stadium. This is the eighth bowl game over nine years held in Texarkana after the 2020 season and postseason were cancelled due to COVID-19 restrictions.

This year's teams were announced and coaches present during a press conference Wednesday at Arkansas High's Red Wall.

The Savage Storm placed fourth in the Great American Conference standings this fall, and head coach Tyler Fenwick was named the GAC Coach of the Year. In 2019, SEOSU finished 1-10 before all of NCAA, Division II football was cancelled last fall.

Emporia State tied for fifth in the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association and lost four games by a combined 17 points.
