

As the Fifth U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals decides the future of the Texas law banning nearly all abortions in the state, local health providers are still trying to help patients seeking reproductive care.

Marva (MAR-vah) Sadler, the senior director of clinical services for Whole Woman's Health in Fort Worth, says it's been a challenging few weeks as the ban was lifted and then re-implemented.
