The key item up for consideration is Governor Asa Hutchinson's tax cut proposal. Joining me is Roby Brock, editor-in-chief of Talk Business & Politics ...

For the highest income tax payers, Hutchinson's proposal would reduce the tax rate from 5-point-9 percent to 4-point-9 percent. He had said repeatedly that he was waiting to issue the call until he was confident he had legislative support. Do you think this will get easy package?
