TEXARKANA, Texas -- Detectives here are still actively working the Halloween party shooting Oct. 30 that left one man dead and another nine people with gunshot wounds.

With more than 200 people inside the event center when the shooting took place, it is taking a long time to try to identify who all was there and then locate these people, said Shawn Vaughn, spokesman for the Texarkana Texas Police Department.

Detective Cliff Harris has been trying to reach out to Kolbe Hemphill and Demetrius Washington for a couple of weeks now, but has not been able to locate them, Vaughn said. He believes these men may have some critical information that will help him piece together what happened that night.
