St. Mark's Episcopal Church Rector Reverend Kevin Gore submitted the letters to authorities and U.S. Postal Service inspectors in Little Rock.

Gore told local media the anonymous letters called for him to resign and had rhetoric alluding to various conspiracy theories spoken by members of QANON.

Gore had written an op-ed in The Jonesboro Sun calling for library board member Mark Nichols to resign - criticizing him for handing out DVD's promoting conversion therapy for LGBTQ-plus members.
