As COVID-19 cases in Arkansas continue on an upward trend, one of Little Rock's longest-running restaurants says it's taking a step to keep its customers and employers safe. Trios announced Monday that all customers must show proof of vaccination or a recent negative test to eat inside. Customers are also still required to wear masks. Trios joins the White Water Tavern and 42 Bar and Table in requiring customers to show vaccination cards. Co-owner Capi Peck, who serves on the Little Rock Board of Directors, says there has been positive as well as negative feedback from customers.
