CONSUMER NEWS:

5:30P NEWS: ACTION NINE: Four days per week, 2:00 in length. Consumer reporter acts as an advocate for consumers who are not getting satisfaction from businesses or government. Tries to help them solve their own problems or encourage the two parties to work out a solution.

FAMILY FOCUS: One report, two minutes in length, and each week focusing on family and children issues. Reports are part of WSOC-TV's station community campaign: Family Focus, which includes PSA's, events, programs, community projects. Also repeats on Saturday mornings.

TRAFFIC REPORTS: Nine times daily during **EYEWITNESS NEWS DAYBREAK** and once each during 7:25 AM and 8:25 AM breaks. Includes alternate route information. Also, half hour in midday if there is breaking traffic news.

WHISTLEBLOWER 9 – A report is done bi-weekly on tax-payer waste.

CLARK HOWARD REPORT – Each Saturday morning a segment is aired and once a week at 5:30 pm. Clark Howard also airs in our 7am/8am on TV 64 and in our 12pm newscast on WSOC from time to time.

9 INVESTIGATES SPECIAL: On Friday, March 11th, from 8p-9p WSOC-TV aired a program that focused on local investigations. The anchors and reporters helped uncover stories of government waste, laws being broken, or important stories that impacted viewers in our viewing area in North Carolina and South Carolina.

STEVE’S COATS FOR KIDS- CHARLOTTE, NC –

For the last 12 years, CMG Charlotte has collected over 100,000 coats during the annual “Steve’s Coats For Kids” campaign. For two weeks every January, CMG Charlotte and Channel 9 Eyewitness News Chief Meteorologist Steve Udelson ask viewers to donate new or gently used coats for needy children in the Charlotte area. In 2016, we collected a record number of 20,385 coats. All coat donations are distributed through Crisis Assistance Ministry serving the Charlotte area since 1975. An independent non-profit agency, Crisis Assistance Ministry focuses on preventing homelessness for Charlotte-Mecklenburg's working poor -- providing assistance with rent, utilities, clothing and furniture. Every coat donation spends less than 48 hours in the Crisis Assistance Ministry Free Store before benefiting someone in need.

MCCRORY ON EDUCATION BUDGET

NEW THIS MORNING...SOME NORTH CAROLINA RESIDENTS SAY IT'S NOT ENOUGH THAT GOVERNOR PAT MCCRORY INCREASED EDUCATION FUNDING BY 57%. IN A WRAPPED UP 2015 YOUTUBE VIDEO, MCCRORY POINTS OUT A 700 MILLION DOLLAR INCREASE IN NEW FUNDING FOR K THROUGH 12 SCHOOLS. HE ALSO TALKS ABOUT 1 BILLION DOLLARS FOR TEACHER PAY RAISES. THE PRESIDENT OF "PUBLIC SCHOOL FORUM", A PUBLIC EDUCATION ADVOCACY GROUP, SAYS THE BUDGET INCREASES ARE INSUFFICIENT CONSIDERING THE GROWTH IN STATE SCHOOL SYSTEMS.

NCAE RESPONSE

NEW NUMBERS OUT TONIGHT SHOW 25% OF TEACHERS IN NORTH CAROLINA HAVE A SECOND JOB. THE REPORT FROM THE "NATIONAL EDUCATION ASSOCIATION" COMES AS GOVERNOR MCCRORY'S OFFICE IS TOUTING A TEACHER PAY RAISE. THEY SAY HIS OFFICE IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE LARGEST TEACHER PAY RAISE IN THE COUNTRY LAST YEAR. CRITICS SAY IT WAS ONLY A ONE-TIME BONUS AND SAY SOME ACTUALLY SAW A DECREASE IN SALARIES BECAUSE OF CHANGES TO LONGEVITY PAY.

TEACHERS PAY DEBATE

ELECTED OFFICIALS IN NORTH CAROLINA ARE EXPECTED TO REVISIT A FAMILIAR DEBATE, OVER TEACHER PAY. GOVERNOR PAT MCCRORY WANTS TO FOCUS ON ANY PAY PROPOSAL GIVING DIFFERENT PAY TO TEACHERS WHO TAKE ON ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES OR INSTRUCT HIGH DEMAND SUBJECTS. IN 2014, MCCRORY PUSHED THE DIFFERENTIATED PAY BUT LAWMAKERS WERE SLOW TO EMBRACE, OR FUND IT. REPRESENTATIVE CRAIG HORN OF UNION COUNTY SAYS HE EXPECTS ACROSS THE BOARD RAISES FOR ALL TEACHERS, WITH DIFFERENTIAL PAY NEXT IN LINE.

CMS STUDENT ASSIGNMENT

CHARLOTTE MECKLENBURG SCHOOL BOARD FORMALLY APPROVED A COUNTY-WIDE SURVEY ON STUDENT ASSIGNMENT. IT WILL GO OUT FRIDAY. THE SURVEY ASKS QUESTIONS ABOUT SCHOOL DIVERSITY, CLASS SIZE, TEST SCORES AND BUS ROUTES. IT'LL BE AVAILABLE ONLINE THROUGH THE CMS WEBSITE AND PAPER COPIES WILL BE IN SCHOOLS AROUND THE COUNTY. SUPERINTENDENT ANN CLARK SAYS SHE FORSEES THIS AS THE FIRST STEP IN A PROCESS TO GET THE DISTRICT READY.

CMS SUPERINTENDENT

THE CMS SCHOOL BOARD IT ONE STEP CLOSER TO RESOLVING IT'S SUPERINTENDENT SITUATION. AT A RETREAT TODAY, MEMBERS SPOKE OPENLY ABOUT WHAT TO DO WHEN CURRENT SUPERINTENDENT ANN CLARK'S CONTRACT EXPIRES IN JULY. UNTIL TODAY, THE BOARD HADN'T PUBLICLY DISCUSSED A SEARCH. THERE WERE DIFFERENT OPINIONS TODAY ON WHAT TO DO.

MARCH 2, 2016 12:00PM

CMS BUDGET-COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

TONIGHT IS YOUR FIRST CHANCE TO GIVE CMS FEEDBACK ABOUT ITS BUDGET PRIORITIES, FOR NEXT YEAR. THE DISTRICT IS HOSTING SIX COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENTS, BETWEEN NOW AND THE END OF APRIL. THEN, THEY'LL GIVE THEIR BUDGET REQUEST TO THE COUNTY. CMS SAYS IT EXPECTS 27 MILLION DOLLARS IN NEW COSTS NEXT YEAR FOR SALARY INCREASES, MORE STUDENTS AND OTHER THINGS. TONIGHT'S MEETING STARTS AT SIX AT SOUTH MECK HIGH SCHOOL ON PARK ROAD.

MARCH 5, 2016**11:00PM****MECKLENBURG EDUCATORS BREAKFAST**

THE CHARLOTTE MECKLENBURG ASSOCIATION OF EDUCATORS HELD A BREAKFAST THIS MORNING TO DISCUSS WHAT SOME ARE CALLING AN EDUCATIONAL CRISIS IN NORTH CAROLINA. THE GROUP MET IN SOUTH CHARLOTTE AT THE COVENANT PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH ALONG WITH MAYOR JENNIFER ROBERTS. TEACHER SALARIES WERE A LARGE FOCUS AT THE MEETING. SOME SPEAKERS SAY IT'S TIME FOR TEACHERS TO LET THEIR VOICES BE HEARD. WE'VE BEEN REPORTING FOR MONTHS – THAT TEACHERS HAVE BEEN LEAVING THE STATE BECAUSE OF LOW SALARIES. THE NORTH CAROLINA BOARD OF EDUCATION CREATED SIX PRIORITIES THEY WANT GOVERNOR PAT MCCRORY TO CONSIDER. THEY WANT THE STATE TO BE NUMBER ONE IN THE SOUTH FOR TEACHER SALARIES. IT CURRENTLY SITS AT 11TH OUT OF 12 STATES.

MARCH 6, 2016**12:00PM****STUDENT ASSIGNMENT THIS WEEK**

WE'RE FOLLOWING A MAJOR STORY FOR YOUR WEEK AHEAD. DAVIDSON, HUNTERSVILLE AND CORNELIUS WILL VOTE THIS WEEK ON RESOLUTIONS REGARDING CMS STUDENT ASSIGNMENT. CMS SCHOOLS REVIEW STUDENT ASSIGNMENT EVERY FEW YEARS BUT PARENTS ARE CONCERNED POSSIBLE CHANGES TO THE PLAN...SENDING THEIR CHILDREN TO SCHOOLS OUTSIDE THEIR NEIGHBORHOOD. RIGHT NOW THE THREE TOWN BOARDS ARE BEHIND PARENTS AND SUPPORT SCHOOL CHOICE. MINT HILL AND MATTHEWS ARE ALSO LOOKING AT SPLITTING FROM CMS.

MARCH 15, 2016**12:00PM****MATTHEWS-CMS RESOLUTION**

MATTHEWS TOWN LEADERS ARE MAKING DEMANDS WHEN IT COMES TO CMS STUDENT ASSIGNMENT. LAST NIGHT, LEADERS UNANIMOUSLY PASSED A RESOLUTION SAYING THEY'RE PREPARED TO LEAVE THE SCHOOL DISTRICT UNLESS CMS GUARANTEES STUDENTS WILL BE SENT TO NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOLS. MOVING FORWARD, MATTHEWS TOWN LEADERS SAY THEY WILL FORM A TASKFORCE TO FIND OUT WHAT PARENTS WANT AND WHAT THE TOWN MUST DO TO GET STATE'S APPROVAL AND FORM AN INDEPENDENT DISTRICT.

\$805 MILLION BOND

C-M-S SUPERINTENDENT ANN CLARK WANTS TO USE 805 MILLION DOLLARS OF TAXPAYER MONEY TO IMPROVE AREA SCHOOLS. OF THAT 805 MILLION DOLLARS 275 MILLION WOULD BE SPENT IN DISTRICT TWO --- FUNDING RENOVATIONS AT HARDING, WEST MECK, AND WEST CHARLOTTE HIGH SCHOOLS, AND FUNDING A NEW HIGH AND K THROUGH 8 SCHOOL. ANOTHER LARGE AMOUNT - 101 MILLION WOULD GO TO DISTRICT FOUR - FUNDING NEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL BUILDINGS AND RENOVATIONS AT EAST MECK, AND ALEBMARLE ROAD MIDDLE SCHOOLS. THIS IS A BREAK DOWN OF WHERE THAT MONEY WOULD GO--A LARGE AMOUNT WOULD GO TO DISTRICT FOUR IN EAST MECK COUNTY TO FUND NEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL BUILDINGS AND COVER RENOVATIONS COSTS AT SEVERAL SCHOOLS. BUT THE MOST MONEY WOULD BE SPENT IN DISTRICT TWO IN THE WESTERN PART OF THE COUNTY.

RIGHT NOW STOCK FUTURES ARE TRADING UP, DESPITE PLUNGING GLOBAL OIL PRICES TODAY. THE MARKET WAS CLOSED TODAY FOR THE MARTIN LUTHER KING JUNIOR HOLIDAY BUT WE'LL BE KEEPING A CLOSE EYE ON HOW THE MARKETS REACT TO THAT AND WHETHER THEY REBOUND FROM LAST WEEK'S TUMULTOUS TRADING WHEN THE MARKETS REOPEN IN THE MORNING.

JANUARY 20, 2016**5:00PM****STATE OF CENTER CITY**

AT THIS HOUR CHARLOTTE LEADERS ARE GETTING AN UPDATE ON THE STATE OF THE CENTER CITY. CHARLOTTE CENTER CITY PARTNERS SAYS THE UPTOWN AREA IS POISED FOR AN EXPLOSION OF GROWTH. A REPORT SAYS BY 2020 OFFICE SPACE WILL INCREASE BY 15% AND UPTOWN HOTEL ROOMS WILL GROW BY 46%. IN ADDITION, THE REPORT SAYS THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE LIVING IN UPTOWN WILL GROW TO 40,000.

JANUARY 27, 2016**5:00AM****NC/SC UNEMPLOYMENT**

NORTH CAROLINA'S UNEMPLOYMENT RATE FELL IN DECEMBER BUT IS STILL HIGHER THAN THE NATIONAL AVERAGE. A REPORT OUT YESTERDAY SHOWS NORTH CAROLINA'S JOBLESS RATE DIPPED TO 5.6% IN DECEMBER. THE STATE ADDED ALMOST 87,000 JOBS IN 2015. IN SOUTH CAROLINA, UNEMPLOYMENT HELD STEADY IN DECEMBER AT 5.5%. OFFICIALS THERE SAY THEY ADDED MORE THAN 10,000 JOBS IN DECEMBER ALONE BUT THE NATIONAL UNEMPLOYMENT RATE IS LOWER THAN BOTH STATES, AT 5%. MORE PEOPLE ARE BEING HIRED TO WORK IN RESTAURANTS, CONSTRUCTION AND HEALTH CARE.

JANUARY 27, 2016**6:00AM****INTEREST RATE DECISION**

EXPERTS SAY THE STOCK MARKETS RECENT DROPS WILL LIKELY STOP THE FED FROM INCREASING INTEREST RATES TODAY. LAST MONTH, THE BANK RAISED INTEREST RATES FOR THE FIRST TIME IN NEARLY A DECADE AND SAID THEY WOULD HAVE MORE GRADUAL INCREASES THIS YEAR. SOME EXPERTS NOW WONDER IF THOSE INCREASES MAY BE SMALLER THAN ORIGINALLY THOUGHT.

FEBRUARY 4, 2016 11:00PM**ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TIERS**

NORTH CAROLINA MAY START USING A NEW FORMULA TO DETERMINE HOW MUCH MONEY TO GIVE TO EACH COUNTY FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE SAYS A THREE-TIER SYSTEM THAT'S BEEN IN PLACE SINCE THE 80S, NO LONGER ACCURATELY RANKS THE POOREST COUNTIES. THEY'RE PUSHING LAWMAKERS TO USE A NEW SYSTEM THAT WOULD COMPARE UNEMPLOYMENT RATES AND OTHER DATA FROM EACH COUNTY TO THE STATE AVERAGE. IT'S NOT CLEAR HOW THIS WOULD DIRECTLY IMPACT LOCAL COUNTIES.

FEBRUARY 11, 2016 6:00PM**STOCKS TOOK A HUGE DIVE**

BANK OF AMERICA STOCK PLUNGED 6.5% TODAY AS TRADING SUFFERED ON WALL STREET. CRASHING OIL PRICES AND CONCERNS OF A SLOWING GLOBAL ECONOMY SPARKED THE SELL OFF. WHEN THE SMOKE CLEARED THE DOW JONES WAS DOWN 254 POINTS. THE NASDAQ FELL 16 POINTS STOCKS ARE NOW AT THE LOWEST LEVEL IN NEARLY 2 YEARS.

FEBRUARY 16, 2016 6:00PM**MECKLENBURG PROPERTY TAXES**

DESPITE AN IMPROVING ECONOMY IN MECKLENBURG COUNTY, TAXPAYERS WON'T LIKELY GET A BREAK ON PROPERTY TAXES. FOR THE LAST HOUR WE'VE UPDATED YOU ON TODAY'S STATE OF THE COUNTY ADDRESS. CHAIRMAN TREVOR FULLER SAID THE TAX RATE WILL NOT INCREASE. HE SAYS CONTINUED CONSTRUCTION HAS HELPED KEEP MONEY COMING INTO THE COUNTY. MEANWHILE, REPUBLICANS ON COMMISSION SAY TAXPAYERS SHOULD EVEN SEE THE TAX RATE CUT BY A PENNY.

FEBRUARY 23, 2016 6:00AM**CIAA KICKOFF**

THE CIAA TOURNAMENT KICKS OFF TODAY FOR THE 11TH STRAIGHT-YEAR. TOURNAMENT SALES ARE ALREADY UP 6% FROM LAST YEAR. IT'S EXPECTED TO BRING 150,000 PEOPLE TO THE CITY AND PUMP MILLIONS INTO OUR LOCAL ECONOMY. THE CITY HAS DECLARED IT AN EXTRAORDINARY-EVENT, WHICH MEANS YOU'LL SEE EXTRA SECURITY. CMPD SAYS IT'S BEEN IN TOUCH WITH AREA BARS AND NIGHTCLUBS. LAST YEAR—VIOLENCE ERUPTED AT TWO VENUES. NEITHER WAS ASSOCIATED WITH THE TOURNAMENT.

MARCH 1, 2016**5:30AM****MORE TAX REFUNDS SAVED**

MORE PEOPLE THAN EVER ARE PLANNING TO PUT THEIR TAX REFUNDS TO GOOD USE. THE IRS SAYS ALMOST 80% OF PEOPLE WILL GET STATE AND FEDERAL REFUNDS THIS YEAR THAT COMES TO ABOUT 330 BILLION DOLLARS IN REFUNDS THIS YEAR. OF THAT, PEOPLE PLAN TO PUT MORE THAN HALF OF IT IN SAVINGS OR TOWARD PAYING DOWN DEBT. ONE CPA SAYS THE MASSIVE AMOUNT OF REFUNDS IS DUE TO THE UPSWING IN THE ECONOMY AND PEOPLE ARE MORE LIKELY TO SAVE BECAUSE OF MONEY CONCERNS FROM THE RECESSION. ALSO, IF YOU HAVEN'T FILED YET, EXPECT TO WAIT LONGER FOR A REFUND BECAUSE OF THE LARGE NUMBER OF FILERS.

MARCH 10, 2016**5:00AM****CHARLOTTE JOB GROWTH**

A NEW SURVEY SAYS CHARLOTTE WILL HAVE ONE OF THE STRONGEST JOB MARKETS IN THE NATION-DURING THIS YEAR'S SECOND QUARTER. THE "MAN-POWER EMPLOYMENT OUTLOOK SURVEY" RANKS THE QUEEN CITY AS NUMBER ONE FOR JOB PROSPECTS. FROM APRIL THROUGH JUNE-IT PREDICTS INCREASED HIRING AMONG CONSTRUCTION, DURABLE GOODS AND MANUFACTURING. BUT'S IT'S NOT ALL GOOD NEWS...IT DID SAY SOME FINANCIAL COMPANIES PLAN TO CUT BACK.

MARCH 22, 2016**6:00PM****X GAMES TO CHARLOTTE?**
