1. RAISE MONEY FOR YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

Program Title: “Austin County Fair Shrimp Boil”

Description: KWHI helped promote the Austin County Fair Shrimp Boil drive through meal on Friday, July 17th at the Austin County Fairgrounds in Bellville. Due to the pandemic, an online auction was held from July 13th to July 17th via the Austin County Fair website and Facebook page, where proceeds went to the Memorial Scholarship for the Austin County Fair. KWHI promoted the event through live DJ liners, and news stories.

Program Title: “Brenham Fireman’s Fiesta”

Description: KWHI helped promote the annual Brenham Fireman’s Fiesta on Saturday, August 8th at the Fireman’s Training Center in Brenham. The event changed from a sit-down meal into a drive-thru fish fry to accommodate for COVID-19 regulations. The event raised funds for the Brenham Fire Department for rescue supplies, training, as well as maintenance for the Brenham Fireman’s Training Center KWHI promoted the event with recorded promotional ads, live DJ liners, an interview during the morning show, Four 1-hour advance remotes to promote the event and pre-sale tickets, featured Brenham Fire Department President Billy Ruemke on KWHI’s Weekly Community Corner, news stories, and a remote broadcast from the Fireman’s Fiesta.

Program Title: City of Brenham's "Guns & Hoses Blood Drive"

Description: KWHI helped promote the annual blood drive held by the City of Brenham Fire and Police Departments. The Brenham Fire Department and the Brenham Police Department held their annual blood drive competition on Friday, August 21 and Saturday, August 22 at the Brenham Fireman's Training Center. Due to the pandemic, the donations were by appointment only, and both days were fully booked. Successful donations were also granted a COVID-19 antibody test. KWHI provided live remote broadcasts from the blood drives on both Friday and Saturday. The blood drive was promoted in advance with recorded promotional ads, news stories, featured Brenham Fire Department's Second Assistant Chief Rob Aguilar on KWHI's Community Corner, and live DJ liners.
