### Religious Freedom and Liberty Issues in America - 13

The pillar with which religious freedom and true liberty in America are constructed is that of knowledge. An intelligent understanding of the high cost of these basic human rights and the constant threats to their continuance is essential. Fundamental changes in both societal and governmental attitudes, towards the "First Freedoms" of the United States, should be monitored and recognized by the populace and responded to accordingly.
