The strain afflicting the children is usually associated with acute respiratory illness, according to the CDC, which on its website instructs health workers to report unusual clusters to state or local health departments.

Some recipients must provide matching funds, but all schools must spend their grant money by the end of next September.

The nassar survivors are especially concerned about ordering colleges to allow cross-examination in cases involving assault allegations.
