School closing information consists of a listing of schools and some businesses in West Michigan that are closed, delayed, or have limited buses running. The purpose of this is to inform students, parents, teachers and concerned others when these establishments are not going to operate in their normal schedules due to adverse weather or other situations.

"Maranda Where You Live" is a locally produced daily half-hour program featuring information, insights and inspiration for West Michigan parents.

WXSP is simulcast entirely on WOBC, Battle Creek, MI; WOHO, Holland, MI; WOKZ, Kalamazoo; WOLP, Middleville; and WOMS, Muskegon, MI.

Doctors are finding the new helmet is having a huge impact on concussions. If the vice-is helmet passes a final safety test, the company hopes to have both N-F-L and college athletes using the helmet as soon

as next season.
