On Friday night June 29, during primetime programming, WDBJ began warning viewers of an oncoming storm. By 9:30 p.m., WDBJ took the air until midnight. A Derecho--a very destructive, widespread wind storm--hit most of our viewing area. Tens of thousands lost power.

On Saturday, June 30, WDBJ had comprehensive coverage during the 60 minute morning show. WDBJ interviewed power company officials about the wide-spread power outages.

Usually, a 30-minute broadcast, WDBJ took the air for one hour during the Saturday, June 30 6:00 p.m. newscast.

On Monday, July 2, WDBJ continued coverage of this historic storm. Instead of two individual, 30 minutes newscasts at 5:00 p.m. and 6:00, WDBJ took the air at 5:00 for a 90-minute newscast.
