BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS SHOWS THAT AIR ON WKAC

WKAC airs the Sick Call Program Monday-Saturday 8:00am till 8:30am. This program provides news about sick and shut in, local deaths, and activities that are available to Senior Citizens throughout the area.

WKAC Classified is a live call in show that allows listeners to call in free of charge and buy, sell or trade items of interest. Airl Monday-Saturday 8:30-9:30am.

WKAC provides free legal help with local attorney William G. Mathews each Tuesday Morning 9:30-10:00. Listener may call in or e-mail questions of legal concerns and get free advice.

WKAC broadcast local area Football games for Athens High School each week on our internet stream and also delays a broadcast for replay on Saturday Afternoon Each of the County Teams are selected for 2 games a year that are also broadcast on our internet stream, channel 2 for live coverage then for replay on Sunday Afternoon.

WKAC host the Athens High School Head Coach, Allen Creasy, each Thursday live from 10-11am to discuss Athens High Football during the season. We also talk with each county football coach every Wednesday-Friday at 11:00am, 12:00pm and 1:00pm to get updates on their previous weeks activities and the upcoming activities, length is usually 15-20 minutes. This gives the fans from all our schools a chance to keep up with their school.

Tailgate Talk airs live Saturday Mornings 10:00-11:00 from the Athens Applebee's. Coaches and players from all the schools and all sports are invited to attend and talk about their game from the previous night and updates on activities going on at their school. This run through the January-June.

The Morning Show has various guests from political figures to the average Joe on the street discussing matters that affect the area. Local political candidates are invited to come in and answer questions from the public, as well as current government and civic leaders, doctors and specialist.

State Representative Dan Williams Host his own show every Monday at 10:00am and discusses events around the state as well as interviews with local people about events taking place.

Athens Mayor Ronnie Marks comes in every Tuesday following the previous Monday Night Council meeting to discuss the events that took place at the council

County Commission Chairman Stanley Meniffee comes by the Tuesday Before each Commission Meeting to discuss upcoming items on the agenda and things going on in County Government.

Ken Creel of the Alabama Extension Agency comes by on Wednesday to answer questions and concerns about home gardening and lawn and garden problems and ways to help improve life at home.
