ISSUE: YOUTH PROGRAMMING

07/11/14 at 19:00...Life on the Rock...60 minutes...Fr. Mark Mary and Doug Barry talked with members from Benedictine College. The college strives to guide young people with truth. Some of the stories shared the real life transformation happening in student's lives while on campus.

07/18/14 at 19:00...Life on the Rock...60 minutes...Fr. Mark Mary and Doug Barry spoke to Margaret Motto and Fr. Burke Masters. They discussed their involvement in nurturing young people in Illinois with their youth program. They teach young people to come to the truth with an open heart.
