Re: Notice of Retransmission Consent Election

Dear Mr. Hubbard:

We recently received a phone call informing us that Grand Valley Telecom (“Grand Valley”) intends to initiate a video service in the Grand Junction-Montrose, CO and/or Denver, CO Designated Market Areas. Nexstar Broadcasting, Inc. (“Nexstar”) is the licensee of television broadcast stations KREX-TV, Grand Junction, CO, KREG-TV, Montrose, CO, KREY-TV, Glenwood Springs, CO, and KGJT-CD, Grand Junction, CO (collectively, the “Stations”), which are assigned to the Grand Junction-Montrose and Denver, CO Designated Market Areas. Please be advised that Nexstar hereby invokes its rights pursuant to Section 325(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Section 76.64(a) of the FCC’s rules, to bar retransmission of the Stations’ signals by your cable system(s) and/or video service without our prior express written authority granted pursuant to a retransmission consent agreement to be negotiated between you and us.

This election is a continuing election from the date hereof through the initiation and provision of service by your systems. In addition, this election is made for each and every community or video service that Grand Valley intends to serve or initiate in the Grand Junction-Montrose and Denver, CO DMAs. Sandra Zoldowski, General Manager of the Stations, will be in contact with you soon regarding a proposed retransmission consent agreement.
