STOLEN ITEMS. PROSECUTORS REQUESTED BAIL, BUT THE ACTUAL JUDGE IN THE CASE SET HIM FEE SAYING THAT THOUGH HE HAS SEVERAL PRIOR ARRESTS, HE HAD NOT MISSED A COURT DATE SINCE

ANOTHER UPDATE ON THAT GRUESOME STORY WE'VE BEEN TELLING YOU ABOUT... FOUR PEOPLE HAVE BEEN ARRESTED... IN CONNECTION WITH THE DISCOVERY OF HUMAN REMAINS IN SUFFOLK COUNTY. AND IT'S CAUSING A POLITICAL DEBATE OVER THE STATE'S BAIL REFORM LAWS... AFTER THEY WERE ALL RELEASED WITHOUT BAIL.
