APRIL IS AUTISM AWARENESS MONTHAIR DATE: APRIL 4, 2021

GUEST: GILLIAN KOHN...CO-CHAIR OF THE CHARLESTON WALK FOR AUTISM. SHE IS ALSO THE MOTHER OF AN 11 YEAR OLD AUTISTIC SON

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE CONDITION KNOWN AS AUTISM. THERE ARE VARYING DEGREES OF THIS CONDITION...WHICH IS CHARACTERIZED BY DEVELOPMENTAL DELAYS CONCERNING SOCIAL INTERACTION...BEHAVIOR...AND OTHER CONCERNS.

MANY TIMES JUST GETTING A CORRECT DIAGNOSIS IS DIFFICULT. BUT AS MORE CHILDREN ARE EXHIBITING DELAYS...MORE IS BEING LEARNED ABOUT THE CONDITION.

THOSE ON THE AUTISM SPECTRUM VARY. SOME ARE VIEWED AS JUST 'QUIRKY'. OTHERS HOWEVER NEVER BECOME VERBAL AND NEED CARE FOR THE REST OF THEIR LIVES.

1 IN EVERY 59 KIDS IS BORN HAVING AUTISTIC CHARACTERISTICS. AND THERAPIES CAN TEACH THESE KIDS HOW TO DEAL WITH THEIR 'QUIRKS' SO THEY CAN BECOME PRODUCTIVE AND FUNCTIONING ADULTS. MANY GO ON TO BE QUITE SUCCESSFUL BECAUSE THEY ARE 'DETAIL' PEOPLE AND LEARN EVERYTHING THEY CAN ABOUT WHAT INTERESTS THEM.

THIS WEEKEND...THERE IS TO BE A FUNDRAISER TO RAISE AWARENESS OF AUTISM WHILE SPOTLIGHTING THEIR MUSICAL TALENTS. IT HAPPENS AT CANE BAY PARK.

NORTH CHARLESTON ARTS FESTIVAL 2021 IS ON!

AIR DATE: APRIL 11, 2021

GUEST: ANN SIMMONS....DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF THE NORTH CHARLESTON CULTURE AND ARTS DEPARTMENT

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE FACT THAT THE ANNUAL ARTS FESTIVAL FOR 2021....IS ON FOR THIS YEAR. THE 2020 ARTS FESTIVAL HAD TO BE CANCELED DUE TO THE CORONA VIRUS.

SIMMONS SAYS THE EARLY DECISION TO HOLD THE ARTS FESTIVAL STARTED BEING APPROACHED LAST OCTOBER. OPTIMISM PREVAILED...AND THE FESTIVAL IS ON! IT IS TO HAPPEN APRIL 28TH THRU MAY 2ND.

SIMMONS SAYS IT SHOULD BE A GREAT 5 DAYS OF ARTS...CRAFTS...FOOD...AND DRINK. THIS YEAR'S FESTIVAL HAS BEEN PARED DOWN A BIT TO ENCOURAGE SOCIAL DISTANCING. BUT IT IS ALSO NOT A HUGE CONCERN SINCE MOST OF THE FESTIVAL HAPPENS OUTDOORS. MASKS WILL STILL BE REQUIRED.

ONE OF THE MAIN ATTRACTIONS IS THE ANNUAL DISPLAY OF ARTWORK FROM LOW COUNTRY STUDENTS. SIMMONS SAYS STUDENTS HAVE HAD A DIFFICULT TIME PRODUCING THEIR ART AT HOME. THE SCHOOLS HAVE THE FACILITIES AND SUPPLIES STUDENTS USE. BUT THERE ARE STUDENTS WHO HAVE BEEN WORKING ON PIECES THEY HOPE TO HAVE DISPLAYED THIS YEAR.

THERE WON'T BE AS MANY FOOD TRUCKS AT THE FESTIVAL...BUT SIMMONS ASSURES ME THE 'BEST ONES' WILL BE ONSITE IN PARK CIRCLE AND OTHER FESTIVAL VENUES.

ITS HOPED 2022...THE FESTIVAL WILL BE BACK UP TO NORMAL AGAIN.

GUEST: HAROLD MEERS....FOUNDER AND ARTISTIC DIRECTOR OF
THE CHARLESTON OPERA THEATER COMPANY

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THIS RELATIVELY NEW ENTERTAINMENT
OPTION IN THE LOW COUNTRY. THE CHARLESTON OPERA THEATER
IS A NON-PROFIT EFFORT THAT HOPES TO RE-INTRODUCE THE LOW
COUNTRY TO OPERA.

A PROGRAM IS PLANNED FOR MOTHERS DAY WEEKEND AT THE
HANAHAN AMPHITHEATER....A STREAMLINED PRESENTATION OF
THE BIZET OPERA CARMEN. IT WILL BE AN ADAPTATION...AND
WILL INCLUDE SONGS AND MUSIC MEERS SAYS HAVE BEEN HEARD
BY JUST ABOUT EVERYONE...EVEN THOUGH MANY MAY NOT
REALIZE IT.

THE MAY 8TH PERFORMANCE WILL ALSO FEATURE A PERFORMANCE
BY COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON'S OPERA SINGERS. AND JUST TO
MAKE THE IDEA APPROACHABLE TO AS MANY AS POSSIBLE...THERE
WILL BE A BEER AND WINE TENT AND AN ASSORTMENT OF FOOD
TRUCKS AVAILABLE.

MEERS SAYS HE NEVER THOUGHT HE WOULD EVER BE INVOLVED IN
OPERA...AS HE WAS INTO HEAD-BANGING ROCK AND ROLL DURING
HIS TEEN YEARS. HE WANTED TO BE A ROCK STAR...BUT SAID HE
FOUND OPERA TO BE A STIMULATING. HE SAYS IT IS AS EMOTIONAL
AS ROCK...AND THAT'S WHAT HE FOUND APPEALING ABOUT IT. HE
HAS PERFORMED IN MANY OF THE GREAT OPERAS ALL OVER THE
COUNTRY AND THE WORLD...BEFORE COMING TO CHARLESTON.

VOICES AGAINST TRAFFICKING...WORKING TO HELP RESCUE
ABUSED CHILDREN

AIR DATE: APRIL 25, 2021

GUEST: ANDI BUERGER...FOUNDER OF VOICES AGAINST
TRAFFICKING AND A CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE SURVIVOR

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE WORK OF LOCATING AND RESCUING CHILDREN BEING SEXUALLY ABUSED THRU TRAFFICKING. THE ORGANIZATION 'VOICES AGAINST TRAFFICKING' CONSISTS OF INDIVIDUALS AND OTHER ORGANIZATIONS WORKING TO RESCUE ABUSED KIDS AND EXPOSE THEIR ABUSERS.

BUERGER WAS ABUSED FOR YEARS BY HER MOTHER...FATHER...AND BROTHER FROM THE TIME SHE WAS 6 MONTHS OLD. SHE SAYS ITS TAKEN A LOT OF YEARS OF THERAPY TO EMERGE FROM THAT HELL...GET HER LAW DEGREE...AND WORK TO HELP CHILDREN EXPERIENCING WHAT SHE SUFFERED THROUGH.

BUERGER SAYS IT'S INSANE WHAT'S NOW HAPPENING AT THE US MEXICO BORDER WITH THE FLOOD OF ILLEGAL IMMIGRANT CHILDREN SHOWING UP THE BORDER. SHE SAYS IT IS NO SECRET THESE KIDS ARE BEING ABUSED...BOUGHT AND SOLD BY THOSE ADULTS WHO ARE ALSO AT THE BORDER 'LOOKING FOR KIDS' TO 'USE' FOR BAD REASONS.

BUERGER SAYS HUMAN TRAFFICKING IS BECOMING MORE AND MORE WIDESPREAD AND THAT MOST OF THE TIME...THESE YOUNG PEOPLE ARE SOLD INTO SEX TRAFFICKING. HER VOICES AGAINST TRAFFICKING WEBSITE HELPS VICTIMS AND CHILD ADVOCATES.

WACCAMAW INDIAN TRIBE LOOKING FOR FEDERAL RECOGNITION
AND RESPECT IN SOUTH CAROLINA

AIR DATE: MAY 2, 2021

GUEST: HAROLD 'BUSTER' HATCHER...CHIEF OF THE WACCAMAW
INDIAN TRIBE IN HORRY COUNTY

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE 'FORGOTTEN' WACCAMAW INDIAN
TRIBE AND THE TRIBE'S QUEST FOR FEDERAL RECOGNITION. CHIEF
HATCHER SAYS THE NATIVE TRIBE HAS BEEN WORKING FOR
DECADES TO BE OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZED AS A NATIVE AMERICAN
TRIBE THAT CAN TRACE ITS HISTORY TO BEFORE THE 1700's.

THE CHIEF TELLS THE STORY OF LAND BEING TAKEN AND
DISCRIMINATION UP THRU THE 1990's.

FEDERAL RECOGNITION WOULD ENABLE THE TRIBE MEMBERS TO
GET THINGS THAT BLACK AMERICANS FOUGHT FOR AND HAVE
ACHIEVED. NATIVE AMERICANS ARE STILL REACHING FOR THOSE
RIGHTS.

CHIEF HATCHER SAYS HE HAS SERVED IN THE U-S ARMY FOR 20
YEARS...YET HE SAYS HE AND OTHERS IN HIS TRIBE HAVE TO PROVE
CITIZENSHIP WHEN ASKING FOR CERTAIN FEDERAL OFFERINGS.

THE TRIBE IS NOW WORKING TO HAVE A PLACE IN SOUTH CAROLINA
HISTORY BOOKS. AND THE TRIBE IS GETTING HELP FROM COASTAL
CAROLINA UNIVERSITY IN SETTING UP EXHIBITS THAT HOPE TO
EDUCATE ALL ON THE WACCAMAW TRIBE.

IN CONGRESS...REP TOM RICE IS WORKING TO HELP THE TRIBE GAIN
THE NATIONAL RECOGNITION OTHER TRIBES HAVE ATTAINED.

NAMI...HELPING PROVIDE SUPPORT FOR THOSE WITH MENTAL
ILLNESS AND QUESTIONS

AIR DATE: MAY 9, 2021

GUEST: ROB AITCHESON....EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE NATIONAL
ALLIANCE ON MENTAL ILLNESS (NAMI)

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THIS LOCAL NAMI CHAPTER. AITHESON
SAYS IT'S THE BEST KEPT SECRET IN THE LOW COUNTRY FOR THOSE
WHO MAY BE SILENTLY DEALING WITH A MENTAL HEALTH ISSUE.

THIS IS A GRASSROOTS ORGANIZATION WITH A NATIONAL
HEADQUARTERS AND HUNDREDS OF LOCAL OUTLETS ALL OVER THE
COUNTRY. NAMI OFFERS SUPPORT FOR THOSE WHO FINALLY WANT
TO TALK ABOUT WHAT THEY ARE FEELING.

AITCHESON SAYS NAMI IS A FREE SUPPORT SERVICE. IT OFFERS
SEMINARS AND INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS WITH ARE
DISTRIBUTED ANYWHERE REQUESTED. HE SAYS NAMI OFTEN GETS
REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION AT SCHOOLS IN THE 5 COUNTIES IT
SERVES HERE IN THE LOW COUNTRY.

AITCHESON SAYS HE SUFFERS FROM BI-POLAR-2 DISORDER...AND IT
TOOK YEARS TO MAKE THAT DIAGNOSIS. HE WAS IN HIS 20s WHEN
HE FINALLY FOUND OUT WHY HE WAS HAVING PROBLEMS. HE SAYS
FOR MANY...TALKING ABOUT MENTAL PROBLEMS IS STILL TABOO.
HE SAYS THERE ARE COUNTLESS PEOPLE WHO DON'T FEEL RIGHT
MENTALLY...BUT THEY DO NOT WANT TO TALK ABOUT IT. IT
MEANS THEY ARE NEVER ABLE TO LIVE THE WAY THEY WANT.

NAMI DOES NOT OFFER MEDICAL SERVICES...BUT IT CAN DIRECT
CLIENTS TO PROFESSIONALS WHO CAN HELP.

THE HOPE PROJECT WORKING TO SAVE THE DRUG ADDICTED

AIR DATE: MAY 16, 2021

GUEST: CHAD LOGAN...FOUNDER OF CHARLESTON-BASED 'THE HOPE PROJECT'

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE HOPE PROJECT...A FAITH-BASED PROJECT WORKING TO HELP PEOPLE GET OFF DRUGS. THE HOPE PROJECT HAS ALWAYS WORKED WITH THE DRUG ADDICTED. BUT IT HAS SINCE BEEN BRANCHING OUT TO HELP THOSE FACING OTHER ADDICTIONS...WHETHER ITS FOOD...PORN...TOBACCO OR SEX.

LOGAN SAYS SOME ADDICTIONS ARE WORSE THAN OTHERS...AND SOME CAN KILL YOU. BUT HE SAYS ALL ADDICTIONS TAKE AWAY THE JOY OF LIVING...BECAUSE YOU BECOME A SLAVE TO THAT ADDICTION.

LOGAN KNOWS WHAT HE'S TALKING ABOUT. HE WAS AN ADDICT FROM THE 5TH GRADE TO THE AGE OF 27. FINALLY HE GOT HELP AND WORKS DAILY TO HELP OTHERS.

LOGAN ALSO FEARS THE LOCAL AND NATIONAL DRUG PROBLEM WILL GET WORSE...THANKS TO THOSE CROSSING OVER OUR SOUTHERN BORDER. WHILE MANY ARE ESCAPING VIOLENCE IN THEIR NATIVE COUNTRIES...OTHERS ARE DRUG CARTELS...LOOKING TO SPREAD MORE DEADLY DRUGS ACROSS AMERICA.

THE HOPE PROJECT HOLDS MEETINGS AT SEACOAST CHURCH AND ALSO ONLINE...REACHING THE ADDICTED ALL OVER THE COUNTRY.

MY SISTER'S HOUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH MONTH

AIR DATE: MAY 23, 2021

GUEST: TOSHA CONNERS....EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE LOCAL BATTERED WOMEN'S SHELTER KNOWN AS 'MY SISTER'S HOUSE'

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON MENTAL HEALTH MONTH AND THE IMPORTANCE OF RECOGNIZING THE MENTAL TRAUMA EXPERIENCED BY VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND THEIR CHILDREN.

CONNORS SAYS PHYSICAL VIOLENCE HAPPENS ALL TOO OFTEN IN THE LOW COUNTRY...ESPECIALLY DURING THE CORONA VIRUS LOCKDOWN. IT WASN'T UNTIL LIFE STARTED OPENING UP AND THE LOCKDOWN WAS LIFTED THAT CALLS TO MY SISTER'S HOUSE WERE CONSTANT.

CONNORS SAYS SIGNS OF BATTERING FADE AND HEAL...BUT THAT THE SHELTER'S CLIENTS ALSO SUFFER A TYPE OF PTSD...AND MENTAL HEALTH REPAIR IS NECESSARY.

THIS UPCOMING WEEK...MY SISTER'S HOUSE HOLDS ANOTHER INSTALLMENT IN ITS 'BREAK THE SILENCE' SERIES. IT WILL BE ON THE MENTAL HEALTH OF VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

CONNORS SAY THE SHELTER HAS A GREAT STAFF OF PROFESSIONALS WHO ARE AVAILABLE TO TALK WITH VICTIMS AND HELP THEM IN THE AFTERMATH OF ABUSE. SHE SAYS IT IS OFTEN A LONG ROAD AND REQUIRES A LOT OF WORK ON THE PART OF THE VICTIMS.

DISCUSSION WITH DEWEY CENTERED ON THIS NEW CENTER. THE GROUNDWORK WAS LAID FOR THE CENTER LAST FALL AND WILL OFFER TWO STUDENT TRACKS. STUDENTS CAN ATTEND AND EARN A BACHELOR...MASTERS....OR DOCTORATE DEGREE IN CHAPLAINCY OR THEY CAN SIMPLY TAKE CLASSES.

THE DEWEYS ARE FUNDING THE CENTER AND IT WILL BE DIRECTED BY DR RON HARVELL...A RETIRED BRIGADIER GENERAL WITH THE AIR FORCE.

REV DEWEY STARTED THE COASTAL CRISIS CHAPLAINCY MORE THAN 30 YEARS AGO...AND HAS TALKED HUNDREDS OUT OF JUMPING OFF THE COOPER AND RAVENEL BRIDGES. HE'S ALSO MINISTERED TO FIRST RESPONDERS....VICTIMS OF CRIME....AND WAS CALLED TO THE SCENES OF THE WALTER SCOTT SHOOTING AND THE MOTHER EMANUEL AME CHURCH SHOOTING.

HE HAS ALSO STARTED A NEW CHAPLAINCY EFFORT TO HELP THOSE IN THE FOOD AND BEVERAGE INDUSTRY IN CHARLESTON WHO ARE BATTLING SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND ALCOHOLISM. IT IS SAID TO BE A BIG PROBLEM IN THAT INDUSTRY.

HE IS HOPING THE CSU CHAPLAINCY CENTER WILL PRODUCE MORE CARING GRADUATES WHO CAN CARRY ON THIS WORK AND MORE.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON DOMINION ENERGY'S OUTREACH TO HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES IN THE 16 STATES THE UTILITY SERVES.

THE UTILITY HAS FUNDED PROGRAMS AT BLACK COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES FOR THE PAST 40 YEARS. THAT EFFORT HAS ESCALATED OVER THE YEARS AND OVER THE PAST YEAR DUE TO THE STRONG EMPHASIS ON SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EQUITY.

DOMINION ENERGY IS FACILITATING A YOUTUBE LIVE STREAM ON JUNE 17TH. THIS WILL BE A LIVE ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION INVOLVING THE PRESIDENTS OF 4 HBCUs....TWO OF THEM IN SOUTH CAROLINA. THEY ARE CLAFLIN UNIVERSITY AND BENEDICT COLLEGE.

THE DISCUSSION WILL DEAL WITH THE CHALLENGES SURROUNDING SOCIAL JUSTICE AND THE PANDEMIC AND HOW STUDENTS WERE AFFECTED.

HOWARD ALSO DISCUSSED THE UTILITY'S OUTREACH TO STUDENTS STUDYING THE 'STEM COURSES'.....SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, AND MATH. THOSE ARE THE STUDENTS...HOWARD SAYS...THAT WILL LEAD WHEN IT COMES TO IDEAS FOR CLEAN GREEN ENERGY.

FATHER TO FATHER...HELPING DADS BECOME A POSITIVE
INFLUENCE IN THEIR KIDS LIFE

GUEST: TOM SWANCIGER...EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF FATHER-TO-FATHER INC IN NORTH CHARLESTON AND MONCKS CORNER

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE FACT THAT NOT ALL DADS ARE PERFECT. SOME ARE INVOLVED IN NASTY DIVORCES...SOME END UP IN JAIL...SOME ARE UNEMPLOYED AND CAN'T PAY CHILD SUPPORT. A SERIES OF EVENTS LIKE THAT CAN MEANS FATHERS ARE ABSENT FROM THEIR KIDS...WHEN THEY REALLY WANT TO BE WITH THEIR KIDS.

FATHER-TO-FATHER HELPS FATHERS OUT OF EMPLOYMENT OR LEGAL RUTS SO THEY CAN BE THE KIND OF DADS THEY WANT TO BE. IT CAN BE DIFFICULT FOR A FATHER TO FIND HIS WAY BACK TO HIS KIDS AFTER A SERIES OF SETBACKS. FATHER-TO-FATHER...A NON PROFIT ORGANIZATION...PUTS DADS WHO WANT TO DO BETTER...IN A 24 WEEK SERIES OF CLASSES. THE SESSIONS DEAL WITH HELPING THESE MEN JUMP THE HURDLES TO NOT ONLY A BETTER LIFE BUT ALSO TO BE BETTER MALE INFLUENCES IN THEIR KIDS' LIVES.

FATHER-TO-FATHER ALSO HELPS TEENS NAVIGATE EARLY LIFE SO THEY DON'T HAVE KIDS THEY CAN'T SUPPORT. THE ORGANIZATION WORKS WITH TRIDENT TECH TO GET YOUNG MEN INTO TRADES PROGRAMS...TEACHES THEM ABOUT MONEY...SEXUAL RESPONSIBILITY...AND HELPS THEM START OUT ON A GOOD PATH.

SWANCIGER SAYS IT DOES NO ONE ANY GOOD FOR A FATHER TO BE LOCKED IN JAIL BECAUSE HE'S OUT OF WORK AND CAN'T MAKE THE CHILD CARE PAYMENTS. FATHER-TO-FATHER HELPS FATHERS

BECOME GOOD DADS FOR THEIR KIDS....AND A POSITIVE INFLUENCE
IN THEIR LIVES.

SECOND CHANCE JOBSAIR DATE: JUNE 27, 2021

GUESTS: COLIN AND DEBBIE SLAVEN...WORKING WITH THE NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION KNOWN AS SECOND CHANCE JOBS

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THIS ORGANIZATION THAT TAKES DISPLACED WORKERS...VETERANS...AND NON VIOLENT OFFENDERS AND PUTS THEM ON A MEANINGFUL EMPLOYMENT PATH.

MANY WERE DISPLACED BY COVID-19 AND HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO FIND WORK. OTHERS ARE VETERANS NOW IN CIVILIAN LIFE AND ARE FINDING IT DIFFICULT TO FIT INTO ANOTHER JOB. AND THEN THERE ARE THOSE WHO'VE HAD NON-VIOLENT RUN-INS WITH THE LAW AND ARE HAVING A DIFFICULT TIME FINDING SOMETHING MEANINGFUL TO DO. SECOND CHANCE JOBS INVITES THESE INDIVIDUALS TO GET TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION IN GREAT PAYING JOBS THAT EVERYONE NEEDS. THESE ARE THE SO CALLED JOURNEYMEN TRADES...SUCH AS ELECTRICAL, PLUMBING, MASONRY, PAINTING, WELDING AND MORE.

SECOND CHANCE JOBS WORKS WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND MANUFACTURERS TO SET UP CLASSES AND APPRENTICESHIPS AND THE EFFORTS COST EMPLOYERS NOTHING. AND THESE ARE FREE EFFORTS FOR THE STUDENTS AS WELL. SECOND CHANCE JOBS GETS INDIVIDUALS INTO GREAT JOBS AND TURN INTO GOOD PAYING CAREERS.

ALSO...SECOND CHANCE JOBS IS ACTIVE IN THE CHARLESTON COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT IN HELPING STUDENTS WHO ARE NOT 4 YEAR COLLEGE MATERIAL. HUNDREDS HAVE BEEN HELPED OVER THE PAST FEW YEARS.
